The 2024 tnAchieves Summer Bridge Program is a **FREE, 14-DAY** program designed to help incoming college freshmen start at a more college-ready level, both academically and socially. Students participate in reading, math and English instruction daily taught by college professors. The courses equip students with the knowledge needed to be a successful college student. At the end of the program, students have the opportunity to test into college-level courses based on ACT scores, saving up to a year of college courses!

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: MAY 10, 2024
Registration is first-come, first-served! Priority will be given to TN Promise eligible students who plan to attend a community college and require corequisite classes.

ELIGIBILITY

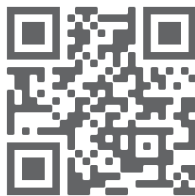
To be eligible for the Summer Bridge Program, students must want to begin college more prepared and:

- 1. Be eligible for the TN Promise scholarship.**
- 2. Require at least one learning support course in college.**

This means below an 18 on the ACT in English OR below a 19 on the ACT in reading and/or math.

- 3. Commit to the entire 14-day program.**

Repeated absence will not be tolerated.
