Academic Requirements

- **Less than 30 hours:**
 - Minimum of a 21 ACT score or SAT equivalent
 - 2.0 Cumulative GPA
- **More than 30 hours:**
 - Official transcripts from all universities/colleges attended
 - 2.0 cumulative GPA

Cost of Attendance

- **Tuition:** \$25,200 per year
- **Room and Board:** \$4,000 per year

Scholarships

- **Cumberland Promise Scholarship**
 - Up to \$16,000 per year
 - Must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better
 - Students must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA based on award level
 - Awarded to students who hold a University parallel associate degree from a regionally accredited institution
- **Ernest L. Stockton Jr. Grants**
 - Up to \$3,400 per year
 - Awarded to students who hold a university parallel degree from an accredited two year or four year university with a minimum 2.50 cumulative GPA
 - Students must maintain a minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA
- **Phoenix Promise**
 - The Phoenix Promise is a last-dollar scholarship, which means that after considering all funding and grants a student is eligible for, the Phoenix Promise covers the remaining balance of tuition and access fees
 - Only available to rising sophomore or junior students at Cumberland, including transfer students
 - Only available for Tennessee residents
 - Not available to nursing majors, athletes or fine arts performing students
- **Private and Endowment Scholarships**
 - Varies by major and/or background

*Spring start students are not eligible to receive scholarships until the fall semester.
