On-Campus Housing*	Apply for housing prior to the start of the semester	Fall Start: April Spring Start: November Housing is provided on a first-come, first-served basis.
Financial Aid Verification	Must be completed before any scholarships/aid can be awarded	Fall Start: July Spring Start: December
Enrollment Confirmation	Fall Start: August 17th Spring Start: January 11th	Fall Start: June Spring Start: December

Scholarships

- **C-N Promise Scholarship**
 - \$2,000 per year
 - Successfully completed an associate degree and remained TN Promise eligible
 - Minimum of 2.5 GPA
 - May be renewed for up to two years
- **Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship**
 - \$1,000 per year
 - Available to transfer students who have participated in Phi Theta Kappa
 - Contact your admissions office to let them know

*Students must live on campus unless they live with a parent within a 50-mile radius, are at least 22 years of age, are a senior with at least 90 credit hours, are married or have a child.
