Scholarships

- **Cumberland Promise Scholarship**
 - Up to \$16,000 per year
 - Must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better
 - Students must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA based on award level
 - Awarded to students who hold a university parallel associate degree from a regionally accredited institution
 - **April 1st** application deadline
- **Ernest L. Stockton Jr. Grants**
 - Up to \$3,400 per year
 - Awarded to students who hold a university parallel degree from an accredited two-year or four-year university with a minimum 2.50 cumulative G.P.A
 - Students must maintain a minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA
 - **April 1st** application deadline

- **Phoenix Promise**
 - The Phoenix Promise is a last-dollar scholarship, which means that after considering all funding and grants for which a student is eligible, the Phoenix Promise covers the remaining balance of tuition and access fees
 - Only available to rising sophomore or junior students at Cumberland, including transfer students
 - Only available for Tennessee residents
 - Not available to nursing majors, athletes or fine arts performing students
 - **April 1st** application deadline

- **Private and Endowment Scholarships**
 - Varies by major and/or background
 - **May 1st** application deadline

*Spring start students are not eligible to receive scholarships until the fall semester.
