College Application	Rolling admission	Fall Start: December Spring Start: October
Apply for Scholarships*	Scholarship deadlines will vary	Fall Start: January Spring Start: November
Scholarship Confirmation	Contact the Financial Aid office for specific dates	Fall Start: March Spring Start: December
On-Campus Housing	Prior to the first day of classes	Fall Start: March Spring Start: November Housing is provided on a first-come, first-served basis.
Financial Aid Verification	Must be completed before any scholarships/aid can be awarded	Fall Start: July Spring Start: December
Enrollment Confirmation	Classes must be confirmed in August for students starting in the fall and in January for students starting in the spring (contact advising for a specific date)	Fall Start: August Spring Start: January

Scholarships

- **[PTK Scholarship](#)**
 - \$1,000 per year
 - Minimum 3.5 cumulative college GPA
 - At least 40 transferable credits
 - Current Phi Theta Kappa member
 - Documentation of membership is required
- **[King Bell Scholarship](#)**
 - \$2,000 per year
 - Students must live on campus to receive this award
 - Scholarship is renewable with satisfactory academic progress

- King Academic Scholarships
 - Amounts will vary
 - Scholarship is based on college GPA
 - Renewable with satisfactory academic progress
