

Knox Access

Objective

Increase the Knox County college-going rate from 59% to 70% for the Class of 2024. A 70% college-going rate equates to approximately 2,800 Knox County high school seniors going to college, representing 400+ more students enrolling when compared to 2021.

Strategy

Working in partnership with KCS school counselors, tnAchieves will work to increase Knox County's college-going rate by assigning five Knox Access coaches to all KCS high schools. Coaches will assist all students in reaching five major benchmarks associated with college access: TN Promise Application, Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), College Application, Orientation and Fall Registration. The goal of Knox Access coaches is to ensure that all students have a clear pathway to a post-secondary institution regardless of TN Promise intentions.

Approach

Each Knox Access coach will be assigned to a KCS region and will be part of the counseling team for those schools. Within that region, coaches will visit each high school once per week and will be available as needed. Coaches will meet with high school seniors to complete college-access milestones. tnAchieves will facilitate a real-time database in partnership with KCS and local post-secondary institutions to track milestone completion.

College-Access Milestones	Benchmark(s)

94% of eligible seniors file FAFSA by April 15	Feb. 15th: 50% file FAFSA.March 1st: 85% file FAFSA.
100% of seniors complete at least one college application by May 15th	 Oct. 15th: 40% submit one college application. Dec. 15th: 65% submit one college application. Feb. 15th: 75% submit one college application.
90% of seniors attend a college orientation by August 1st	April 15th: 30% attend orientation.May 15th: 60% attend orientation.
80% of seniors register for fall classes by August 1st	 April 15th: 30% register for fall classes. May 15th: 70% register for fall classes. May 15th: 100% of seniors report post-high school graduation plans.

70% of seniors enroll in post-secondary for the **fall semester**.

The following data summarizes Class of 2023 TN Promise student progress and anticipated college-going impact. Setting a college-going rate goal of at least 70% for each high school will ensure that Knox County achieves 70% by 2024 and creates a county-wide college-going culture.
