<u>Apply for Scholarships</u>	Merit-based scholarships are awarded upon admission	Automatically Awarded
<b>Scholarship Confirmation</b>	Contact the Financial Aid office for specific dates	Fall Start: <b>March</b> Spring Start: <b>November</b>
<u>On-Campus Housing*</u>	Housing assignments will be made prior to classes starting	Fall Start: <b>December</b> Spring Start: <b>June</b> Housing is provided on a first-come, first-served basis.
<b>Financial Aid Verification</b>	Must be completed before any scholarships/aid can be awarded	Fall Start: <b>July</b> Spring Start: <b>December</b>
<b>Enrollment Confirmation</b>	Classes must be confirmed in <b>August</b> for students starting in the fall and in <b>January</b> for students starting in the spring (contact advising for a specific date)	Fall Start: <b>August</b> Spring Start: <b>January</b>

**Scholarships**

- **TWU Transfer Merit Awards**
  - Ranges from \$8,000-\$16,000 per year
  - Minimum 3.0 cumulative college GPA
  - Based on your cumulative college transfer GPA
- **PTK Scholarship**
  - \$1,000 per year
  - Current Phi Theta Kappa member

\*Students are required to live on campus unless they meet the following criteria: parent lives within the 25-mile commuting area, student is married, has a child, is a military veteran, is an independent student defined by financial aid criteria, is a senior at the university or is attending part time.
