Apply for Scholarships	Fall 2024 Start: February 1, 2024 Spring 2025 Start: October 1, 2024	Fall 2024 Start: May 1, 2024 Spring 2025 Start: December 15, 2024
Scholarship Confirmation	Check your TTU email account frequently after you apply to ensure you accept any scholarship offers promptly.	Deadlines will vary by award
On-Campus Housing	Fall 2024 Start: January 1, 2024 Spring 2025 Start: November 1, 2024	On-campus housing is available on a first-come, first-served basis. TTU's housing application typically opens in October each year
Financial Aid Verification	Fall 2024 Start: June 1, 2024 Spring 2025 Start: November 1, 2024	Must be completed before any scholarships/aid can be awarded
Enrollment Confirmation	Fall 2024 Start: July 1, 2024 Spring 2025 Start: December 1, 2024	Classes must be confirmed no later than the Saturday night before the first day of classes.

Estimated Cost of Attendance

- **Tuition and Fees:** \$10,830 per year
- **Room and Board:** Prices may vary based on residence hall and meal plan. Average dorm cost is about \$6,168 per year and average meal plan is about \$6,108 per year

Scholarships

Tech Transfer Pride Scholarship*

- Award amounts range from \$1000 to \$3,000 per academic year
- Renewable for up to three years (six semesters)
- Must be transferring with at least 12 transferable credit hours
- Must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative transfer GPA.
- Spring admissions application deadline: December 15th
- Fall admissions application deadline: May 1st

Tennessee Tech Promise

- Must have a total adjusted gross income of \$40,000 or less as determined by the FAFSA
- Be eligible for the HOPE Scholarship and federal Pell Grant
- Enroll as a full-time new student
- Awarded automatically to eligible students and is renewable up to 4 years

PTK Scholarship*

- \$3,000 per year
- 3.5 cumulative college GPA
- At least 60 transferable credit hours
- Current Phi Theta Kappa member
- May 1st application deadline

All-Tennessee Academic Team Scholarship*

- Must have a minimum 3.5 cumulative transfer GPA
- Award amounts will be \$4,000 per year
- Scholarship is renewable for three years (six semesters)
- Must be a Phi Theta Kappa member chosen by your Tennessee Board of Regents Community College to be their designated selection for the All-Tennessee Academic Team
- February 15th application deadline

All-Tennessee Academic Team Scholarship*

- Must have a minimum 3.5 cumulative transfer GPA
- Award amounts will be \$4,000 per year
- Scholarship is renewable for three years (six semesters)
- Must be a Phi Theta Kappa member chosen by your Tennessee Board of Regents Community College to be their designated selection for the All-Tennessee Academic Team
- February 15th application deadline

Departmental and Donor-Funded Scholarships**

- Varies by major and/or background
- December 15th application deadline

*Students may only receive one of these awards. If a student is eligible for more than one award, they will be offered the greater of the two.

**Spring start students are not eligible to receive departmental scholarships until the fall semester.

** Departmental and donor-funded scholarships can be combined with each other and with an Admissions scholarship.
