Scholarships

- **Transfer Scholarship**
 - Renewable award of \$2,000 per year
 - Must have a 3.25 cumulative GPA and 60 earned semester credit hours completed (or an associate degree)
 - Must enroll full-time each semester and successfully complete a total of 24 credit hours during the fall and spring terms
 - Academic performance is reviewed at the end of the spring semester. You must have a minimum overall cumulative GPA of 3.00 to remain eligible for your Transfer Scholarship.
 - **June 1st** application deadline
- **Academic Service Scholars Program**
 - \$4,200 per year
 - Minimum 3.0 cumulative college GPA
 - Demonstrate a record of community service/volunteer work in school and/or community
 - Ensure submission of three recommendations through the online scholarship application
 - Commit to working 125 hours each semester in a department on campus

*Dates may vary, check website for more information. Scholarships cannot be applied until spring semester.

**The exception to this is scholarships awarded directly by a UTC department. Those funds are immediately entered as 'accepted' on the student's behalf.
