Scholarships

- **UT Promise Scholarship**
 - Covers tuition and mandatory fees
 - Must maintain HOPE scholarship eligibility
 - Household income under \$60,000
 - Application must be completed by **July 1st** for fall and **December 1st** for spring
 - 8 hours of community service
- **Volunteer Transfer Scholarship**
 - Between \$1,500 and \$5,000 per year
 - Minimum 3.25 GPA
 - Received an AA or AS degree
 - Awarded upon admissions

- Tennessee Pledge Scholarship
 - Covers tuition, mandatory fees and an average cost of on-campus room and board
 - Must be a Tennessee resident
 - Graduate from a Tennessee community college
 - Annual household income of \$40,000 or less
 - Must submit all admissions items prior to the deadline

- F. Rodney and Dell R. Lawler
 - Must transfer from Pellissippi State Community College
 - Demonstrates academic and leadership achievement as well as financial need
 - One year award, can be considered for renewal if 2.5 GPA is maintained
 - Meant to assist with annual maintenance fee

- One Year Scholarships
 - Awarded on the basis of merit or need
 - Most award amounts are between \$500 - \$2,500
 - Submit transfer student scholarship application by **July 1st**
